

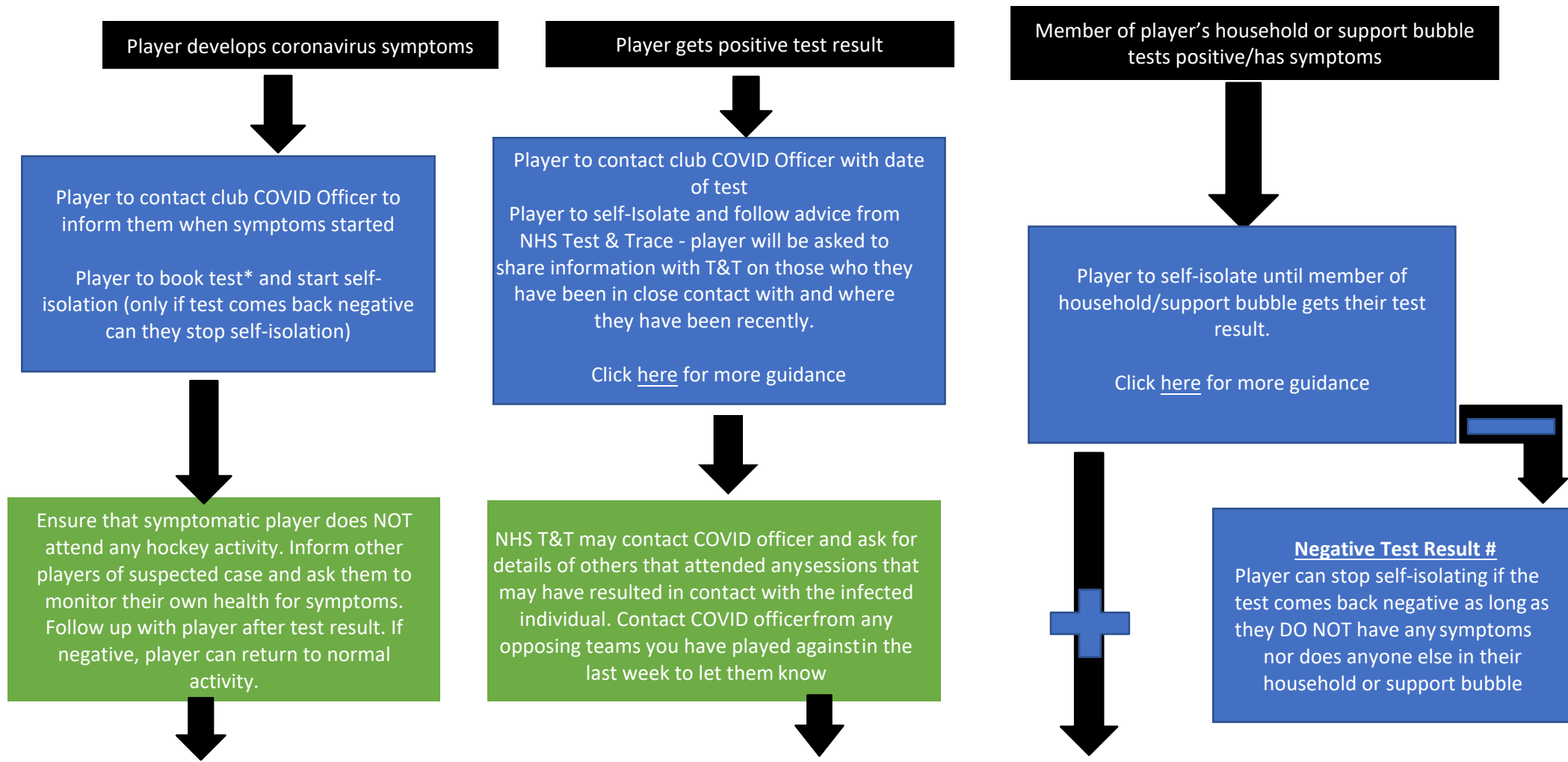
FLOW CHART FOR MANAGING CONFIRMED OR SUSPECTED COVID CASES

Player actions

COVID Officer actions

Definition of contact:

Within 2m or less of a symptomatic/positive person for more than 15 minutes continuously (e.g. car sharing/ waiting together at venue/teas/spectators). It is unlikely that players will reach the 15 minute threshold during a game or training session, but this may need to be considered on an individual basis.



NHS T&T will advise contacts of positive test individual to self-isolate. If players are not contacted by T&T they DO NOT need to self-isolate and can continue normal activities

Positive Test Result/No Test Result
Self-isolate in accordance with NHS guidelines.
Inform club COVID officer that they are self-isolating due to a positive case in their household/support bubble and DO NOT return to training until self-isolation period is complete and they are symptom free

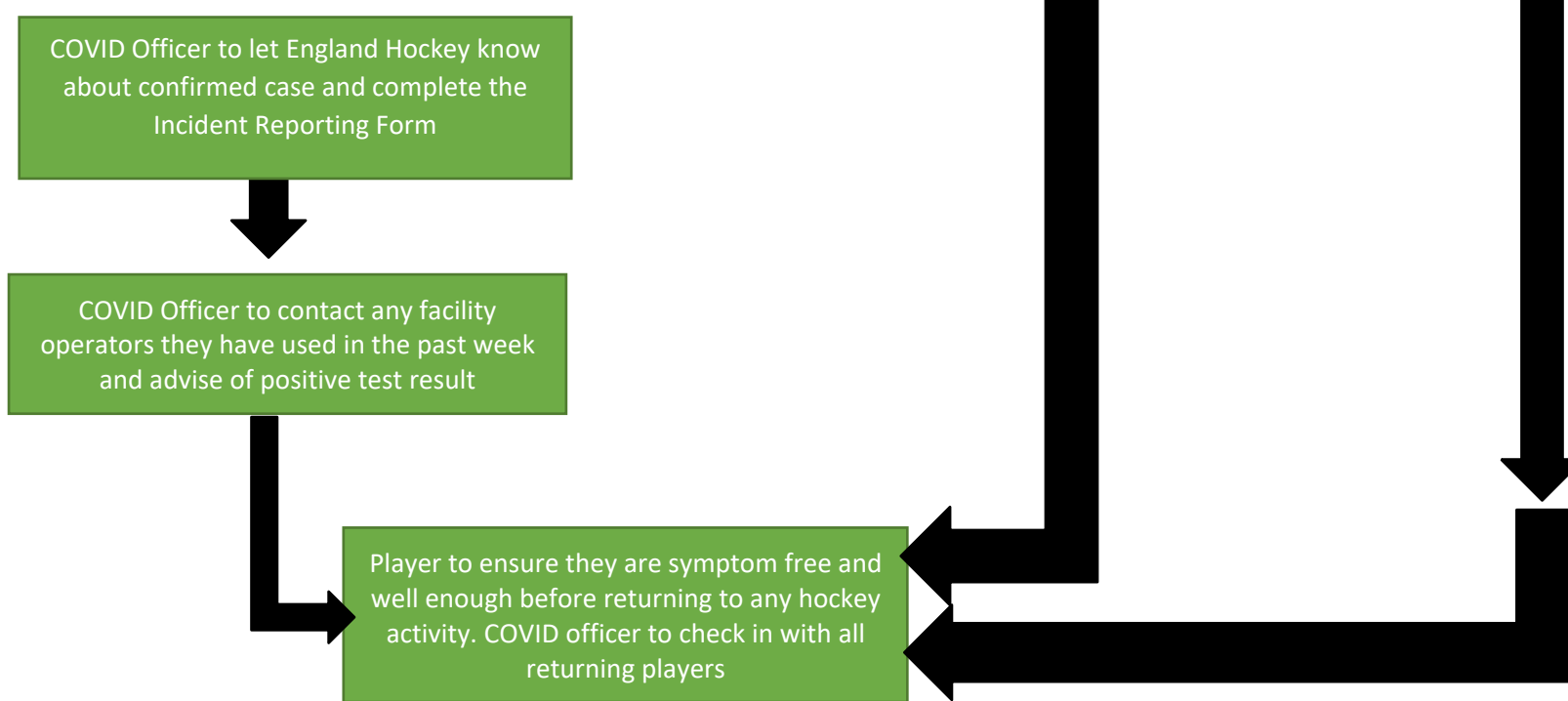

Self-isolate in accordance with NHS guidelines.

Player does not need to book a test unless they develop symptoms or are instructed to do so by NHS T&T.
Player can return to hockey activity once they have completed their self-isolation period as long as they remain symptom free

COVID Officer to notify members that there has been a positive test/player with symptoms at a session they have attended.
Remind them of general precautions/hand washing etc.
If they develop any of the coronavirus symptoms, advise that they arrange a test* and inform the COVID Officer.
Individual may continue normal activities.



*ONLY get a test if you have at least one of the following symptoms: high temperature, a new, continuous cough or a loss or change to your sense of taste or smell.

#Guidance for schools may vary so please follow the guidance sent out by your school.
